PREVENTING BED BUGS WHILE TRAVELING

- 1. Inspect your bed for signs of infestation.
 - Blood spots or tiny insects in the creases around edges of the mattress.
 (Must pull the mattress cover back to inspect.)
- 2. Keep your bags / luggage off of the floor if possible (especially at night).
 - Set luggage up on luggage stands or on tables.
 - Keep hygiene bags and purses on the bathroom counter or on a table.
- 3. Luggage encasements are available on the internet if you want to use them.
 - Garbage bags can also be used as luggage encasements.
- 4. Spray your luggage with Temprid Readyspray (15 oz. aerosol can) upon your return home.
 - Vacuum luggage with a crevice tool.
 - Do this in the garage or outside the home.
 - This is a good idea even if you used a luggage encasement.
- 5. Take dirty clothes out of the luggage in the garage when you get home and put them directly in the washer.
 - Items you do not want to wash should be put in the dryer on high heat for 30 minutes.
